This institution, Chandigarh College of Engg. & Tech., Chandigarh, (Diploma Wing) has been also registered as Vocational Training Provider (VTP) vide registration No. 14010003 and registered with RDAT Faridabad for running the following modular Employable Skills (MES) courses under Skill Development Initiative (SDI) Scheme as on 22/07/2009.

No fund for the initiation of this scheme was received by this institute, but the actual reimbursement of Training cost and Testing/assessment fee of passed trainees received time to time from RDAT, Faridabad / Directorate, Technical Education, UT, Chandigarh.

INTRODUCTION

- ❖ Ministry of Labour & Employment in pursuance of excellence in vocational training has developed skill development initiative (SDI) Scheme based on 'Modular Employable Skills (MES)' framework in close consultation with industry, State Governments & experts.
- ❖ MES is 'Minimum skill set which is sufficient to get an employment in the labour market. These can be learned through professional training institutes or through professionals in formal & non formal way for ones gainful employment.
- ❖ MES allows skill upgradation, multi skilling, multi entry & exit, vertical mobility and lifelong learning opportunities in a flexible manner. It also allows recognition of prior learning (certification of skills acquired informally) effectively.

OBEJECTIVE

- ❖ SDI Scheme is a five year project during which one million persons would be trained or their existing skills tested and certified under Modular Employable Skills (MES) framework.

COURSES & CURRICULA

- ❖ Demand driven short term MES Courses decided in consultation with industry.
- ❖ Courses would also be available for person having completed 5th standard.

TRAINING

- ❖ Central Government will facilitate and promote training while industry, private sector and State Governments will train the persons.
- ❖ Optimum utilization of existing infrastructure to make training cost effective.
- ❖ Flexible delivery mechanism (part time, weekends, full time, and onsite/offsite) to suit needs of various target groups.

- ❖ In order to maintain quality of training uniformly all over country, learning media will be developed.

TESTING & CERTIFICATION

- ❖ Testing of skills of trainees by independent assessing bodies/ industry associations, which will not impart training, to ensure that it is done impartially.
- ❖ The essence of the scheme is in the certification that will be nationally and internationally recognized by both the Government agencies and industry/ trade organizations.

FEE & REIMBURSEMENT

- 1) Rs. 500 per module for having duration up to 90 hrs.
 - 2) Rs. 1000 per module for having duration up to 91 to 180 hrs.
 - 3) Rs. 1500 per module for having duration up to 181 to 270 hrs.
 - 4) Rs. 2000 per module for having duration more than 270 hrs.
- ❖ Candidates belonging to SC/ST category and women will be given relaxation of 25% in training fee. In order to motivate trainees to take the training programme seriously, training fees of all those trainees who successfully complete training would be refunded to them.
 - ❖ Training cost @ Rs. 15/- per person per hour will be reimbursed to registered VTPs in respect of those successful persons who got training from it. VTPs will reimburse training fee to the successful candidates.
 - ❖ A onetime advance of Rs. 3.00 Lakhs will be paid to each Govt. ITI so that they can start courses under the SDI Scheme.
 - ❖ Testing fee will be Rs. 300-800. The testing fee will be reimbursed to all the successful persons who have received training from approved VTPs.
