Chandigarh Skill Development Mission (CSDM) was constituted by Chandigarh Administration to cater the skill need of Chandigarh in year 2017. In the month of August 2018, the approval for launching PMKVY was granted by Chandigarh Administration to CSDM. After the process of EOI, SMART Accreditation and SDMS this office established total 16 Centres in Chandigarh, out of which 12 centre's were established in month of January 2019. After mobilization, total 1000 students are enrolled through the CSDM portal in said centre's. These students are from different marginal groups i.e Dropouts, EWS, Unemployed, Various Marginal groups etc. In order to motivate these students from time to time and support them to become a part of the society, all 12 Training Centre's i.e. NITTTR, CCET , IndoSwiss Training Centre's and Nine Private Training Centre's have been connected through the mode of Video conferencing via Google Hangout mode. This being one more step towards Digitalization, it was inaugurated by Sh Sachin Rana , IAS Special Secretary Technical Education - cum- Mission Director(CSDM) on 25th February, 2019. During this motivational event, all 1000 students were addressed by Sh Sachin Rana, IAS Special Secretary Technical Education - cum- Mission Director , in which he emphasised that Skill India Mission is not just a program to generate employment, but to instill self confidence in the youth of India and imbibe a new energy to the Nation. It is the

Stepping Stone which will help in mobilizing and empowering youth with industry-relevant skill and securing a better livelihood. All Sixteen Training Centers are established in Sector 43, Maloya, Manimajra, Sector 26, Sector 34, Sector 35 and Industrial Area, Chandigarh etc. The Courses of Web Developer, DEO, Retail, telecom, CNC Turning, fitter, welding etc. are available at Twelve different locations.
